5. Focus on Skill Development:

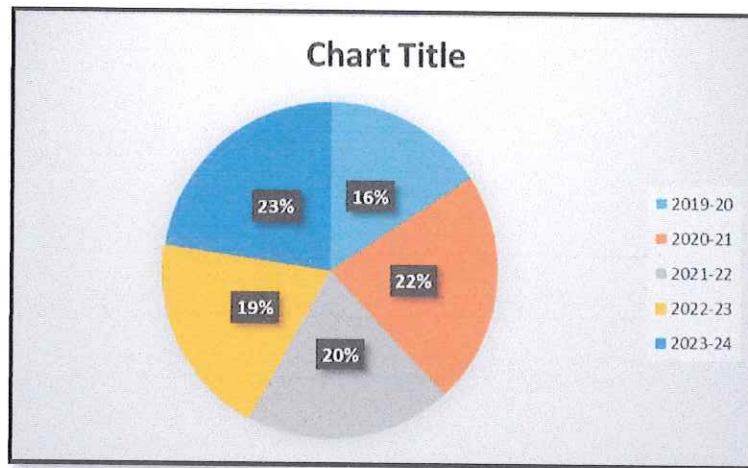

Rana's charity cake auction was an overwhelming success, garnering immense support from the community. The funds raised were directed to various local charities, including relief for earthquake victims in Turkey.

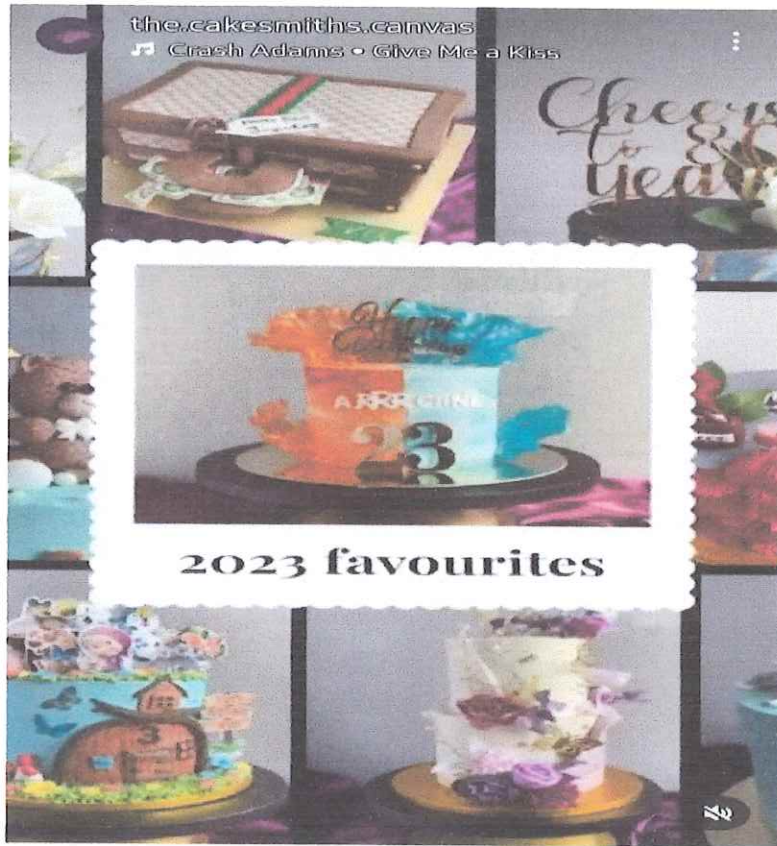
- **Financial Impact:** The auction generated substantial funds, which were donated to several charitable causes, benefiting both local and international communities.

2. Humanity First Foundation:


